BEFORE LESSON:	 Create a Google Form for teachers and students to share their favorite music! Select a few songs to share during the lesson. Customize the SAMPLE PowerPoint as desired or make your own! Create the Kahoot to be played during class. See the SAMPLE PowerPoint for suggestions on what to include. 	
LESSON:	 Share the Music In Our Schools Month PowerPoint. Play the Kahoot. Fill out the Favorite Song and Artist share sheet and display in the hallway. Share a few pre-selected favorite songs from the school community. 	
SHARE TIME:	Have students discuss what music means to them and the positive impact it has in our lives!
